



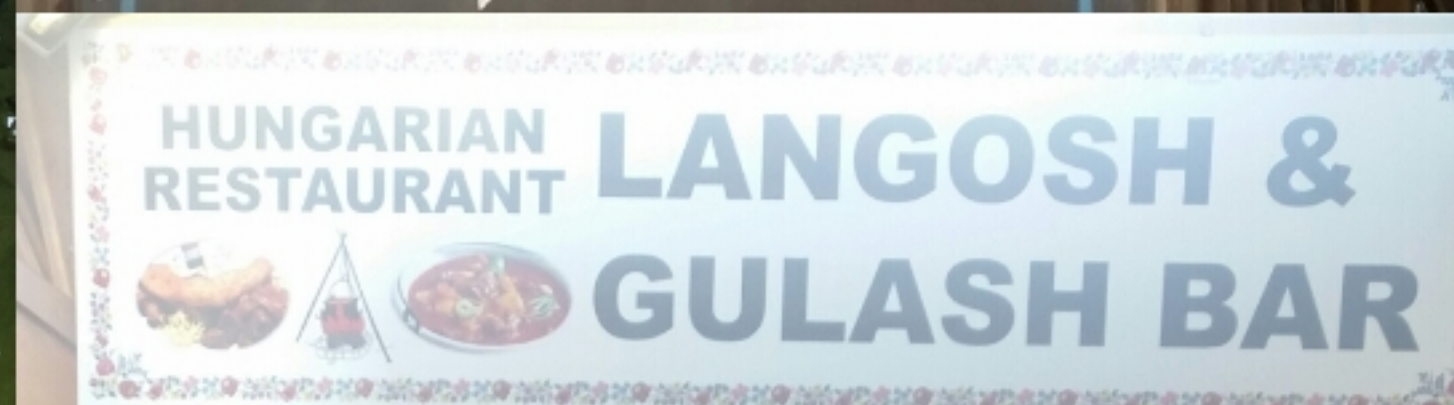
Budapest
